





INTRODUCTION

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

EDLINGTON LEISURE CENTRE

The Council recognises that Edlington should be a priority for future investment and that the community is lacking this key community asset. We recognise the potential for high impact upon the health and wellbeing of the Edlington community.

The output will be a new multi-functional leisure centre for Edlington. The learning and understanding gained through Get Doncaster Moving highlights the need for personal and cultural development through key assets such as leisure centres, which demonstrate that we are personally investing in the community and would help start the path to a regenerative neighbourhood.

EDLINGTON TOWN CENTRE REGENERATION

Local government has a mandate to provide clean, safe and functional public spaces for residents across all neighbourhoods, but there has been notable underinvestment in Edlington for many years and the area needs an uplift. Our plan is to enhance the main shopping area, market place and link streets to prioritise pedestrians and improve access, support the regeneration of the high street, business use of empty properties, and sustainable transport.

The area will be revitalised with more green spaces, improvements to buildings, and highway safety improvements. The plan to connect the two shopping areas will help to provide a more coherent sense of place, improve community access and safety, and to enhance the public realm including new green planting schemes.
